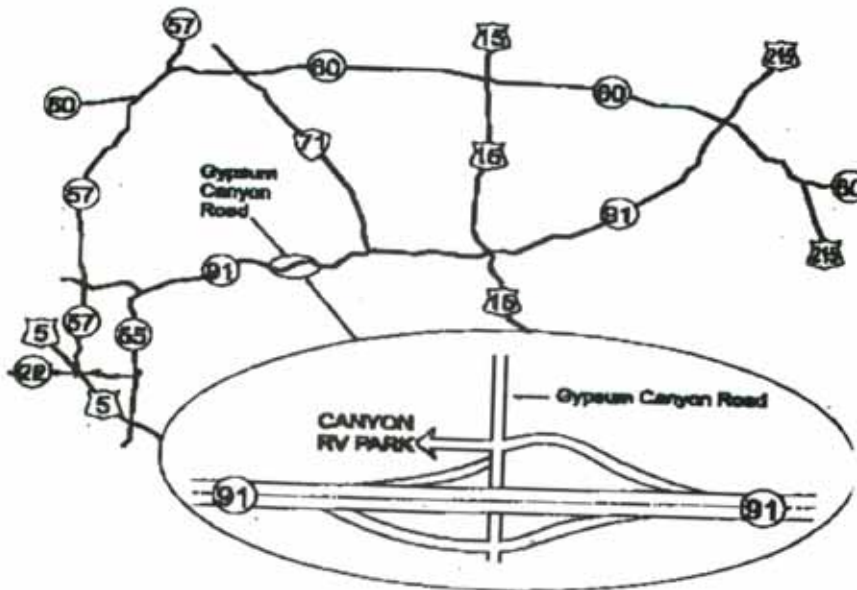

**CLASSIFICATON  
Eligibility of Dogs**

1. Dogs six months of age or older and registered with the American Kennel Club are eligible to participate in earth dog tests as are spayed and neutered dogs and dogs with limited registration provided they are classified as an eligible breed.
2. NOTE: Bitches in season shall not be eligible to enter the test. Entry fees paid for a bitch that comes into season shall not be refunded.
3. Dogs that are blind or deaf shall not be eligible. Blind means without useful vision and deaf means without useful hearing.

**Non-Regular Classes - (no Credit Toward Title):**

Introduction to Quarry: Open to all eligible dogs.  
 Irondog: Any dog holding an ME title is eligible to enter Irondog. This consists of passing 2 tests in one day – SE and ME.

**Regular Classes:**

Junior Earthdog: Open to eligible dogs.  
 Senior Earthdog: Open only to dogs that have acquired JE or ME Titles.  
 Master Earthdog: Open only to dogs that have acquired SE or ME Titles.  
 Note: Dogs that have qualified, but not titled, in an ME Test at an AKC licensed or member club test are ineligible for Junior.

**RUNNING ORDER**

**All dogs, including pre-entries, must check in with the Test Secretary prior to closing time for their class.**

Running order will be established as entries are received (except for Master).  
 Pre-entries will run before Day of Show entries.  
 The Gate Steward will post running order.  
 Dogs entered in Master must be present prior to **7:45 am**, for the drawing of braces.  
 It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to know their running order and be at the entry gate on time. Judges will not wait for late entries. Any entry that is late will be moved to the end of the running order. (Other than Master).

## RIBBON PRIZES & TROPHIES

Light Green ribbons are offered for passing Introduction to Quarry

Dark Green Rosettes are offered to all Master, Senior and Junior Qualifying dogs.

### Saturday Trophies:

WHWTCC offers a soft toy to all dogs passing Intro.

WHWTCC offers a crate pad to all dogs qualifying in JE, SE and ME.

WHWTCC offers a dog done picture frame to all dogs earning titles at these tests.

### Sunday Trophies:

WHWTCC offers a soft toy to all dogs passing Intro.

WHWTCC offers a stainless steel hanging dog bowl to all dogs qualifying in JE, SE and ME.

WHWTCC offers a stainless steel paw print canister to all dogs earning titles at these tests.

WHWTCC offers a car seat organizer for Irondog both days.

## IRONDOG

Any dog holding an ME title is eligible to enter Irondog. This consists of 2 tests in one day – SE and ME. The dog must pass both tests to earn a trophy. This is not a title. The cost for an Irondog entry includes both ME and SE classes.

**All ribbons & trophies will be distributed each day after lunch, except for ME.**

## MOVE UPS

Dogs may be moved up to a higher class at the request of owner, as a result of qualifying for an Earthdog title, provided the request is made in writing to the Test Secretary no later than closing time for that class.

### AGREEMENT

I(we) acknowledge that the "Rules Applying to Dog Shows/Registration and Discipline" and if this entry is for an Earthdog Test, the "Regulations for Earthdog Tests" have been made available to me(us) and that I am (we are) familiar with their contents. I(we) agree that the club holding this show or earthdog test has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem to be sufficient. In consideration of this entry and the holding of the show or earthdog test and of the opportunity to the dog judged and to win prize money, ribbons or trophies, I(we) agree to hold this club, its members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or show secretary and Canyon RV Park and any employees of the aforementioned parties, harmless for any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or upon the show or earthdog test premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto. And I(we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless for any claim for loss of this dog by disappearance, theft, damage or injury, be caused or alleged to be caused by the negligence of the club or any of the parties aforementioned, or by the negligence of any other person, or any other cause or causes.

I(we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves) or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this show or earthdog test, howsoever such injuries, death or damage to property may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents, or any other person.
